Working with Hayley Stevenson, James Meadowcroft, and others in Canada, the UK, and Australia, I am part of the Value of Nature project. The project is funded by Riksbankens Jubileumsfond, The Wellcome Trust and VolkswagenStiftung ('Europe and Global Challenges' initiative). We study how international and domestic actors translate the concept of ecosystem services and engage in policy learning influences the concept's diffusion and implementation. Specifically, we aim to build an advanced understanding of the emergence and evolution of the ecosystem services concept; to interrogate practical experiences with ecosystem services, for their effectiveness and equity; and, to examine how IOs, NGOs, and domestic actors engage in reflexive practices, and the consequences of these practices.
